Hi Judy:

If a person wants a Burn Permit for Presque Isle they must be a resident of Presque Isle. They would need to come to the Fire Department and they actually obtain one (1) permit from the Maine Forest Service and one (1) from the City of Presque Isle.

The permit fee is Ten Dollars (\$10.00), payable in cash or check and all the person needs to do is answer several questions: Name, address of where they will be burning, and phone number. What they planning to burn, (ex. Campfire, Brush, Grass & Pasture & Blueberry Land). Safety Requirements (Garden Hose, Hand Tools, number of adults, etc.)

Permit is good for the calendar year only.

Each time a person wants to burn they must contact the Fire Department and obtain permission, because if it is to dry or to windy they may not be allowed to burn.

The person must also have both permits available to show to a member of the Maine Forest Service or Fire Department if requested.

Person can not burn garbage, painted or varnished wood, tires, etc.

Person should only be burning grass, brush, tree limbs, leaves or untreated wood.

Person can be summons to court by the Maine Forest Service if they are burning material that is not allowed, burning without a permit or burning without contacting the Fire Department to ask permission to burn.
